

Bright Beginnings Mother's Day Out COVID-19 Guidelines

Prior to COVID-19, we followed strict cleanliness policies. As we re-open, we will be enhancing our cleaning and sanitation procedures to ensure the health and safety of our staff, children, and families. The staff will be following State and CDC guidelines for preventing the spread of coronavirus. Please be aware of the following steps that are crucial to keeping our school open.

1. Before entry into our facility, ALL individuals will have temperature taken. This includes staff. Entry will be denied if individuals exhibit signs of risk. Outside visitors will be limited.
2. Parents will be required to pick up and drop off children through church entry doors and exit through MDO doors. We will have teachers help with walking children to their classrooms. We ask that parents do not walk to child's class.
3. All snacks will be prepared in individual bags for each child.
4. Children are provided with individual supplies, such as crayons, markers, play dough, and pencils and do not share with classmates.
4. Comply with CDC recommendations for proper hand washing, sanitizing, and disinfection.
5. All classrooms will have no more than 10 individuals (students and teachers).
6. If children, family members, or staff feel sick or exhibit signs of illness, we ask that you remain at home to monitor. Keeping our school healthy is important to remaining open!
